Celebrate Spring with Egg Hunt, the Beatles, and More at Avon Grove Library

West Grove, Pa., March 14, 2016 – From a Spring "Eggstavaganza" to the Beatles to crafting classes and storytimes, Avon Grove Library offers many events for children, teens, and adults throughout April. Learn about all our storytimes and programs at our website, www.avongrovelibrary.org.

Children's Programs:

- "Pajama Storytime" welcomes all ages for an evening of stories, songs, crafts, and fun to end the day. Pajamas are encouraged at this free, no-registration story hour, held Wednesdays at 6:30 p.m.
- "Open for Construction," a new free, no-registration STEM program, will gather children in Pre-K through third grade Saturday, April 9 between 9:30 and 11:30 a.m. to build with construction toys.
- "Preschool STEM," held April 12, 1–3 p.m., invites families with children ages three to kindergarten to drop in for STEM play. No registration is needed for this free program.

Teen Programs:

- An Eggstravaganza for 6th-12th graders will be held at Penn Township Park on Friday, April 1, 7-9 p.m. Teens will enjoy breakfast foods for dinner and search for eggs throughout the park. A \$2 fee and registration are required.
- "Learn to Knit" teaches beginning teens and adults the basics needed to complete a Project Linus square. Register for a free 15-minute knitting lesson to be given April 9, 2:30-3:30 p.m.

Adult Programs:

- Beatles scholar Aaron Krerowicz will present "The Beatles: Band of the Sixties" on April 8, 7-8 p.m., exploring the music of the Fab Four in a multimedia presentation spanning the full decade. Music clips and interview excerpts will supplement this program. This free program requires no registration.
- As part of the annual Community Read sponsored by Longwood Gardens, Avon Grove Library Book Club will read *Grandma Gatewood's Walk* by Ben Montgomery. Readers will gather April 21 at 6:30 p.m. for discussion and refreshments.
