<u>TEEN DIY EASTER BASKET</u>



Supplies:

Easter basket template

Cardstock paper

Printed origami paper

Scissors

Stapler or glue

To create your Easter basket, transfer the template to cardstock paper.

Cut out the base from cardstock. The body of the basket is the 9 squares. The long strip is the handle and the 2 circles will cover where you have attached the handle

On the 9 square portion of the template, cut where the lines are ----- (broken) and fold where the line is ______unbroken/straight. (See photo #1)

Trim nine squares from the origami papers, slightly smaller than the faces of the box so that they leave a thin border when mounted.

Stick the squares of origami paper onto your Easter basket base (body, see photo #2)

Start to assemble the Easter basket shape by folding and creasing along your score lines, folding up the sides and starting to push them gently into shape. (See photo #3) Glue or staple where the sides overlap. Glue or staple handle in place, glue circles at either side of the base of the handle.
