Easter Egg Buddies



Supplies:

- Plastic Easter Eggs
 Many eggs have small holes exactly where some of the décor (like the bunny
 ears or chick feet) should be. The chenille stems usually fit perfectly in the
 holes. When working with the holes in the eggs you might need to use a bent
 paper clip to make the hole slightly larger to accommodate the chenille stems.
- Tacky Glue
- Google Eyes
- Chenille Stems
- Misc Cardstock or Colored Paper
- Pom Poms (or pieces of cotton ball for bunny tail)
- Permanent marker
- Other seasonal embellishments (optional)

THE BUNNY BUDDY



Fold and cut a chenille stem in half. Use these pieces to create ears. Make the nose in little heart or another shape out of card stock or colored paper. Tacky glue on all the pieces, such as the google eyes, paper nose and pom pom tail to the egg. Use more colored cardstock to create a base and glue on for feet. Draw on whiskers and mouth with a permanent marker.

THE CHICK BUDDY



To make the legs and feet, fold and cut a piece of chenille stem into thirds. Two of these pieces are legs. Cut the 3rd piece in half and form feet. (Twist the smaller piece around one end of a larger piece and form toes). Place in holes at bottom of egg/ trim if needed. To make a beak, take a half of another chenille stem, form into a V shape and glue onto the egg. Glue on google eyes. Cut and glue paper wings. Glue onto cardstock base.
