Avon Grove Library offers Free AARP Tax Assistance & Return Preparation

West Grove, Pa., January 10, 2017 – The AARP Foundation Tax-Aide has partnered with Avon Grove Library to offer help with federal, state and local personal income tax returns on Wednesdays, February 15 through April 12.

Appointments are available at the library between the hours of 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. Taxpayers must have an appointment to participate. Those interested can stop by the library to sign up or call 610-869-2004. Users of this service do not need to be a senior citizen or a member of AARP to participate.

The AARP Tax Aide Program provides free, confidential face-to-face assistance at senior centers, community centers, libraries and other convenient locations. Volunteers are trained and certified in cooperation with the Internal Revenue Service to prepare personal income tax returns that provide taxpayers with the maximum allowable credits and other benefits. This program is the nation's largest provider of free tax assistance and return preparation services, with over 35,000 volunteers at more than 5,000 sites helping over 2.6 million taxpayers in 2015.
